

**ORDINANCE NUMBER 2013-01 CREATING AND ENACTING SECTION OF THE PLAINVIEW CODE OF ORDINANCES CONCERNING**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to adopt fees, penalties, and charges by ordinance;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PLAINVIEW, MINNESOTA AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Section 801 of the Plainview Code of Ordinances is hereby created and enacted to read as follows:

**Ambulance Fees**

\*\$100.00 Refundable deposit (WITHOUT interest) when project is completed within 180 days and the final inspection is completed. Examples would be: Decks, New Garages, Additions, Structure moving, and Demolition. \*

Reissue of Expired Permit	Equal to original permit fee
Failure to Obtain Building Permit	A sum equal to two times the building permit fee applicable to the project

**Miscellaneous Fees**

**A miscellaneous fee shall be paid by the applicant for expenses which the City incurs. Such expenses may include, but are not limited to, direct City payroll and overhead costs, costs of printing, mailing and supplies, and fees paid to consultants/professionals. Such miscellaneous fees shall come due immediately upon notification by the City. Upon request, the City shall provide a breakdown of the various expenses incurred by the City. The City may withhold any final action and/or rescind prior actions until all miscellaneous fees are paid in full. The City may request additional deposits if deemed necessary.**
