## OPENING/CLOSING DATES

The Pool will open for public use beginning Monday, June 1, 2015

**MASS REGISTRATION WILL BE HELD ON May 4, 2015 FROM 6:00 – 8:00 P.M. AT THE NEW PUBLIC WORKS BUILDING.**

HOURS: The Pool will be open to the public Sundays – Fridays from 1:00 – 5:00 pm and 6:30 – 8:30 pm, and Saturdays from 12:00 – 6:00 pm.

ATTIRE: Must wear swim suits only. No flotation devices or goggles with nose pieces.

DAILY RATES: Over 1 year old: \$5.00 per day (includes Saturdays) OR \$3.00 for the afternoon (Sun. – Fri.) OR \$2.00 for the evening (Sun. – Fri).

- Family Membership \$130.00 **(Includes Immediate Family Members Only)**
- Single Membership \$80.00
- \*Pool Memberships are only good for the 2015 season.
- 3 Day Punch Pass \$10.00/individual

SWIM LESSONS: \$30

WATER EXERCISE: \$2.50/session or \$25.00 Punch Card or \$100 for the season

ADULT SWIM: Thursday nights. Can use membership, punch card, or \$2.50 per day. Trial period through June.

POOL RENTAL: The Pool can be rented for birthday parties, family groups, organizations, company parties and other activities.

Rental Rates: \$80.00 for up to 25 people (\$2.00 for each person over the 25)

\*To reserve a date to rent the Pool for your group, call the Pool at 534-2701. A one week notice is required.



\*All instructors are trained in the Red Cross Program and are qualified to teach all classes. If you are doubtful of your own or your child's physical condition, consult your physician.

### POOL CLOSURE POLICIES

Temperature: If the temperature is not at least 65 degrees according to accuweather.com, the pool will not open for the afternoon session. Opening for the evening session will be re-evaluated at 6:00 pm. Exemptions will apply for swimming lessons, water exercise, pool rentals, and adult swim.

Storms: If a severe thunderstorm or tornado warning is issued for Wabasha county the pool will immediately close. If thunder is heard or lightning seen by staff the pool will immediately close until one half hour after the last thunder is heard or flash of lightning is seen. If it is after 3 pm the pool will close for the remainder of that session. If it is after 7:45 pm the pool will close for the night. If heavy rains are present, the pool will clear until the rain has passed.

Attendance: If there are people at the pool at 1:00 p.m. the pool will open. If 10 people are not at the pool by 2:00 p.m. the pool will close for the after-noon. If 10 people are not at the pool by 7:20 p.m. the pool will close for the night.

Unsafe Condition(s): If a condition that is not safe is found, the pool will close until the situation is corrected, or directed by the state health department standards.
